Risk management is the essential element in medical device quality management system. It evaluates the risk level of all potential risks, and diminishes them down to a manageable risk level via preventive actions. Proper control of risks within medical device industry could certainly benefit both patients and local SMEs itself. Our seminar would explicitly focus on how local SMEs could adopt and implement medical device risk management system.
