Introduction

Risk factors exist in every business operation, and should be well-controlled especially within medical device industry. If such risks are not carefully identified and manipulated, patient safety could be under great threat. Risk management is the approach to eliminate or at least minimize both the prevalence and severity of these risk factors. Risk management is the essential element in medical device quality management system. It evaluates the risk level of all potential risks, and diminishes them down to a manageable risk level via preventive actions. Proper control of risks within medical device industry could certainly benefit both patients and local SMEs itself. Our seminar would explicitly focus on how local SMEs could adopt and implement medical device risk management system.
