## Measurement of safety performance

The third IOSH Hong Kong Annual Safety Conference and 14th AGM and Annual Dinner will be held at the Salisbury – YMCA of Hong Kong. The theme of the Annual Safety Conference 2014 is 'Measurement of safety performance'. The conference will showcase good practices and provide a platform for both local and overseas professionals to exchange ideas and share their experiences of improving occupational safety and health standards in various sectors.

At present, many enterprises in Hong Kong use accident or injury rates as an indicator for measuring safety performance, but the traditional performance measure can only provide a post-accident indicator that is rather reactive – neither preventing incidents nor proactively driving for good safety results. The measurement of safety performance in an organisation is important as it provides information on the progress and current status of the strategies, and reflects the results of past actions to control risks to health and safety. These indicators measure not only the failure, but also the status and effectiveness of controls in the workplace. Measuring safety performance is not easy and there is no simple and straightforward solution.

### Who should attend?

The conference will be relevant to executives, professionals and managerial staff, particularly health and safety professionals and those with responsibility for health and safety at work.

### Why should you attend?

The conference will provide an important forum for the meaningful exchange of good practices and ideas of measuring performance, and an excellent opportunity to share ideas, network with colleagues, make new contacts and learn from others in the industry.

IOSH members are invited to attend the Annual General Meeting of the Hong Kong Branch immediately after the conference to hear about the branch's priorities and plans for the year ahead, and to see the new branch committee voted in.
